Utah Update

UPMRA 2023 Legislative Highlight

The House Majority Leader introduced and passed HB301, which reduces the indexed portion of the State gas tax by 2 cents until 2028, and shifted some of the tax burden to public electric vehicle charging stations, where a 12.5% charging fee will be imposed. Residential and free charging is exempt. The bill also imposes a higher (+\$7) registration fee on EV vehicles.

Motor Fuel Tax Decals Available!

The 2-cent fuel tax reduction is effective July 1, 2023, and while there is no law requiring retailers to post fuel tax decals on their pumps, UPMRA's Fuel Tax Decal program was successful with members in 2015 and in 2019, so the executive committee decided to print new fuel tax decals for all interested retailers. Stickers are available for counties with and without the additional ¼ cent sales tax, and white decals for retailers with contracts disallowing colored decals on pumps.

Utah Motor Fuel Tax Decals Available!

There is no law requiring retailers to post fuel tax decals on their pumps, but the UPMRA board of directors are offering complementary Fuel Tax Decals. Decals are available for counties with and without the additional ¼ cent sales tax.
